THE FOLLOWING FOUR ITEMS ARE NECESSARY FOR A COMPLETE APPLICATION

1 A CERTIFIED SEALED COPY of your high school transcript documenting a 2.50 GPA **must be sent by your high school to: Lothian Ruritan Club, P.O Box 43, Lothian, MD 20711.**

2 A ONE PAGE, single spaced essay describing your VOLUNTARY community service(s). Voluntary community service is the primary evaluation criteria! The essay must include: a) a specific brief description of the various activities you performed; b) approximate time devoted to each activity; and c) a statement about what you derived from your community service activities. An itemized list of activities is NOT acceptable!

3 A letter of recommendation from your mentor/supervisor in no more than two organizations that have been your major community service activities.

4 On the application page, a “planned field of study” must be stated even if only tentative. A “blank space,” “unknown” or “don’t know” are not acceptable responses.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- *All scholarships are for \$1,000.00, unless otherwise noted, and are awarded in \$500.00 installments/semester.
- *In all cases, a decision in awarding a scholarship is based on strongest record of voluntary community service.
- *Note in the essay any personal or familial connection to the Lothian Ruritan Club, if applicable.
- *Both the applicant and a parent/guardian must SIGN AND DATE the application.
- *One scholarship is restricted to a Southern High senior planning to pursue non-Degree training toward certification in a recognized career path training program. This fact must be stated in the essay.
- *One scholarship is restricted to a member of a Boy or Girl Scout troop within the Club’s service area. Specific mention of this membership should be indicated in the required essay.
